DAY1 o Venice - Arrive in Charming Venice

Venice is elegant and classic with the domes and bell tower of St. Mark's Square shaping the illustrious skyline. Your private transfer will meet you at Marco Polo Airport upon your arrival and escort you to the comforts of your gorgeous boutique hotel where you can sink into the ambiance of the canals and the incredible views from your room. DAY2 o Venice - Discover Venice and the Lagoon Islands

Your private guide will take you on an excursion across the Venetian Lagoon, starting at Burano. Alluring pastel homes contrast the delicate decor stemming from the history of lace-making. Narrow canals crisscross between traditional homes before you reach Murano, the island renowned for its glass. You may feel the heat pushing through the workshops as artisans demonstrate the craft. Travel next to the charming island of Torcello for a serene lunch in a historic garden, and then discover Venice's treasures. From the Rialto Bridge to the Doge's Palace, with an after-hours visit to St. Mark's Basilica, every minute of the day will overflow with wonder. Accommodation Meals:

DAY3 o Lake Garda - Enjoy Wine Tasting and Scenic Beauty

You can visit the gardens of Villa Cimbrone and look out over the Terrace of Infinity for a panorama sweeping across the coastline. In the evening, the flavors of the coastline and the Campania region will enchant you as your private chef reveals the secret of fresh ingredients that result in dishes like gnocchi alla sorrentina and delicate sfogliatelle. | DAY 10 | 0 | Ravello - Explore the Stunning Amalfi Coast |
| | | The splendors of the Amalfi Coast are understated and your guide will introduce you to the marvels of the towns that dot the Campania coastline. The eponymous city of Amalfi has winding cobbled lanes that carry hints of an illustrious past embodied in the elevated position of the cathedral and its 11th-century bronze doors. The fishing village of Atrani may feel like a hidden gem nestled into the steep cliffs overlooking the |

DAY 11 o Ravello - Revel in a Full Day on Gorgeous Capri

After breakfast, you will have a day on a private boat to sail to the renowned island of Capri, whose beauty has drawn the likes of Roman emperors and Hollywood darlings. Lunch on the boat will give you a secluded and private view set between the distant shores of the Amalfi Coast and beckoning Marina Grande of Capri.
