DAY 1 ○ ARRIVAL BARCELONA, SPAIN

Assist you with arrival in Barcelona, where you will be greeted by your Guardian Angel, transfer to your hotel and check-in. Spend the rest of the day in your free time.

DAY 2 ○ BARCELONA | THE GREATEST & TAPAS TOUR IN GAUDÍ

With your private guide, discover the masterpieces of Catalonia's famous architect Antoni Gaudí, starting at Casa Mila, also known as La Pedrera. Next, visit the visually arresting Sagrada Família Basilica. Started in 1882 and still unfinished, it combines Gothic influences with Art Nouveau. Finally, stop at Parc Guell, a beautiful municipal garden with a gatehouse where Gaudí lived in his later years, to view personal memorabilia alongside the furniture he designed. Tonight, enjoy a tapas tour, wandering through some of Barcelona's most interesting tapas bars to sample delicious snacks.

DAY 3 ○ BARCELONA | TO THE GOTHIC REGION

Discover the true heart of the old town - the medieval Gothic Quarter, where you'll explore narrow, labyrinthine streets and quiet squares that are quite different from the rest of the city. See the magnificent 13th-century cathedral, noted for its beautiful Gothic chapels, medieval choir stalls, and shady cloister. Next, visit the magnificent Palau de la Música Catalana, a symphony of stained glass, ceramics, ironwork, stone and brick, created by Gaudí's great contemporary Domènech i Montaner and now classified as a World Heritage Site. Enjoy your afternoon at your leisure.

DAY 4 ○ MADRID | CITY TOUR & PRADO MUSEUM

Transfer to the train station this morning to board the AVE train to Madrid, where you will be greeted on arrival and privately transferred to your hotel. This afternoon, tour the Spanish capital with a visit to the Royal Palace, which has rooms filled with art treasures and antiques. Continue to the world-famous Prado Museum to admire the works of Spain's three great masters, Goya, Velazquez and El Greco.

DAY 5 ○ TOLEDO OR SEGOVIA | YOUR CHOICE OF TRIP

Today, you can choose a full-day trip to Toledo, visit its sixth-century Cathedral, and head to the Santo Tome church to see El Greco's Tomb of the Count of Orgaz. Stop at the 14th-century El Transito Synagogue and tour the El Greco House and Museum. Alternatively, get out of the city today and travel through the Sierra de Guadarrama mountain range to discover Segovia, one of Castile y Leon's most fascinating cities. Enjoy a walking tour of the city taking in the magnificent Roman aqueduct and narrow streets. You will also visit the Alcazar, an archetypal fairytale castle with a gabled roof, tower and battlement. You may want to enjoy a lunch on your own from the traditional suckling pig that Segovia is famous for. Continue your explorations just outside Segovia with a visit to the magnificent royal palace of La Granja de San Ildefonso, with its delightful gardens and elegant rooms.

DAY 6 ○ CÓRDOBA | JEWISH NEIGHBORHOOD & MEZQUITA

Private transfer to Madrid train station to catch a train to Córdoba, one of the oldest cities in Spain. Upon arrival, meet a local guide to walk the flower-filled streets of the Jewish Quarter and visit the medieval Mezquita, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. From its humble beginnings as a small Christian Visigoth temple, the site was greatly expanded by the Muslims who conquered Spain in 711 and is today considered an excellent example of Moorish architecture. See the Christian Baroque nave at the heart of the old mosque. This afternoon, drive through the stunning countryside to Granada.

DAY 7 ○ GRANADA | LEGACY OF MOORS AND MONARCHES

Visit the Alhambra, a remnant of the Muslim occupation of Andalusia. Admire the Alcazaba fort and the Royal Palace of this once mighty fortress, and then wander through the beautiful gardens of the nearby Generalife Palace. Continue into the city for a walking tour that includes the Cathedral and the Royal Chapel, the burial place of the Catholic Monarchs who funded the expeditions of Christopher Columbus. Whenever you have time, visit Albaicín, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to learn about Moorish history or the Sacromonte region, noted for its cave houses.

DAY 8 ○ RONDA & SEVILLE | THE ARENA

Journey to Seville, where you stop on the way in Ronda, a city strikingly elevated above a deep gorge, join your local guide on a stroll through the narrow streets, and visit the Plaza de Toros (bullring), an impressive arena with Moorish architecture. Continue to Seville and get settled in your luxury hotel. Transfer to Tablao El Arenal for an authentic flamenco show tonight. Tablao El Arenal is housed in a 17th-century building and its architecture and decoration is typically Andalusian. Enjoy a free drink during the show and then return to your hotel.

DAY 9 ○ SEVILLE | FROM THE CATHEDRAL TO THE BARIO

Explore the historic heart of Seville, starting with the enormous 15th-century Seville Cathedral, a breathtaking jewel of medieval Christianity. Next, check out the exquisitely carved La Giralda, a tall 12th-century Moorish minaret. amazing visit Visit the 14th-century Alcázar and enjoy a walk through the stunning Barrio de Santa Cruz.
