DAY 1 ARRIVE CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

DAY2 CAPE TOWN | LOOK AT THE SIGN OF HOPE

Take the cable car up to Table Mountain to take in an inspiring panorama of the city. Head to the colorful and diverse Bo-Kaapdistrict for a walking tour. After lunch, explore the Fortress of Hope, built by the Dutch East India Company. Learn about colonial history and then continue to the District Six Museum, which chronicles Cape Town's apartheid past in a poignant but ultimately refreshing way. Get an overview of key historical role players, including Nelson Mandela. Enjoy a comforting welcome dinner tonight.

DAY3 6 CAPE TOWN | CAPE POINT & BOULDERS BEACH

Explore Cape Point, the scenic headland at the continent's southwestern tip. Cross the "bikini beaches" at the base of the Twelve Apostles Mountain Range along the bustling fishing port of Hout Bay and towering over the famous Chapman's Peak Drive. Explore the stunning Cape Peninsula and Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, home to rare bonteboks and chacmababoons. Climb the "Flying Dutchman" funicular to the grand peak at noisy Cape Point, which dominates dangerous reefs and sandy beaches. Visit the endangered African penguin colony at Boulders Beach; they offer people familiar, endless photo opportunities. DAY5 DRIVING ON ROVOS RAIL | DIAMOND MINE MUSEUM

Arrive this morning in Matjiesfontein, an authentically preserved Victorian village. Travel to the Great Karoo, a vast semi-desert region that was once an inland sea, and observe its arid beauty from the observation wagon at the back of the train. The next day, tour the Diamond Mine Museum in Kimberley and have the opportunity to see one of the largest hand-excavated excavation sites in the world. Continue through the grasslands of the gold-rich Highveld, admiring the changing landscapes.

DAY7 JOHANNESBURG | HEART OF SOUTH AFRICA

DAY 10 COBE NATIONAL PARK | LOTS OF WILDLIFE WATCHING

Today, to see predators at their most active, go on morning and afternoon game drives, starting with an early morning safari, avoiding most visitors, thanks to the ideal location of your lodge. Explore along the Chobe River as your experienced guide interprets bush markings and trails to look for resident wildlife. Watch for elephants, large herds of buffalo and many other predators such as lions, wild dogs and even leopards.

DAY 11 OKAVANGO DELTA, BOTSVANA | AN AWARD-WINNING EXPERIENCE

Fly into the Okavango Delta via Kasane Airport. Arrive at the magnificent Sanctuary Chief's Camp in the Mombo Concession of the immense Moremi Game Reserve. Often referred to as the "Predator Capital of the World", this reserve is home to only a few campgrounds that provide a unique and valuable game viewing experience away from the crowds. Observe how the lush delta attracts extraordinary birds and wildlife, including the Big Five, on an afternoon game drive covered in a refreshing Scenic Sunset.

DAY 12 OKAVANGO DELTA | GAME DRIVES AND THE BIG FIVE

Get up early for a game drive in the reserve where the game viewing is really amazing. Activities include the seasonal opportunity to Ride Like a Local, glide over the delta in a mokoro (shelter canoe), and a Chef's Table experience that gives you a taste of traditional local cuisine. Afterwards, go on another safari with your expert guide; your expert guide can take you off the beaten path for a glimpse of a newly caught cheetah,
