DAY 5 ○ **VIENNA SIGHTSEEING AT LEISURE**

We are privileged to visit the Kunstkammer at the Kunsthistorisches Museum this morning before the doors open to the general public, accompanied by a knowledgeable guide, who will explain some of the 2100 valuable objects safeguarded there. Collected over many centuries by Habsburg emperors and archdukes and displayed across 20 galleries, there is sure to be something to spark your interest.

We will then visit the Hofburg Palace, official residence and workplace of the President of Austria, originally built in the 13th century and expanded under the direction of many different architects. The Palace now contains many different aspects. We will also explore imposing buildings, such as the Opera House, St. Stephen's Cathedral and the Parliament Building, all with their own unique architectural features.

The afternoon will be yours to spend on your own. Perhaps you wish to visit the Sigmund Freud Museum, or perhaps take a rest in Cafe Central where Freud and many other historical figures once frequented.

Our Local Specialist will guide you through the most interesting aspects and you may gather a truly authentic impression of the life of the Habsburg monarchy. The beautiful grounds are also a popular spot for the Viennese.

DAY 7 ○ **VIENNA - ESZTERGOM - BUDAPEST (3 NIGHTS)**

We will stop in Esztergom, one of the oldest towns in Hungary to absorb fantastic panoramic view of our final destination, from Castle Hill, domed Cathedral and St. Thomas Hill.

DAY 8 ○ BUDAPEST SIGHTSEEING & AT LEISURE

Our local specialist will guide us through the sites of both Buda and Pest. Starting with a walking tour of the Castle District of Buda, the Fisherman's Bastion and the Matthias Church. We will then drive to Pest to see the Dohány Street Synagogue, which you have the option to spend more time exploring in more detail, in the afternoon.

There will be time to spend at leisure in the Jewish Quarter, where you may shop for traditional gifts such as embroidery and fine porcelain and/or relax with a coffee and pastry (kréme).

In the evening we will be treated to a very special Be My Guest dinner, courtesy of the Schieszel family who will enchant us with stories of their winery.
